

PUBLIC NOTICE

SPECIAL COMPETITION FOR ACCESS AND ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS INTO UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMMES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MAIA 2025/2026

(This public notice revokes the previous version, dated 4 November 2024, following the publication of Order No. 528/2025, dated 10 January 2025, by the Minister for Education, Science and Innovation)

CANDIDATES

Applications within the scope of this competition are open to Non-EU nationals, as laid down in Decree-Law no. 36/2014 of 10 March, as amended by Decree-Law nº 62/2018 of 6 August, and in the Regulations on the International Student Statute of the University of Maia (available on the institutional website).

According to the provisions of the aforementioned law and regulations, the following are not considered international students and therefore cannot apply within the scope of this competition:

- a) Those who are relatives of Portuguese citizens or citizens of a Member State of the European Union, regardless their nationality;
- b) Those who are not nationals of a European Union Member State but who have been legally residing in Portugal continuously for at least two years on 1 January of the year in which they intend to enter higher education, and any of their children who legally reside with them;
- c) Those who, on 1 January of the year in which they intend to enter higher education, enjoy the status of equal rights and duties assigned by any international treaty signed by Portugal and the country of their nationality.
- d) Those who apply to higher education in the scope of the special regimes under the provisions of Decree-Law no. 393-A/99 of 2 October, amended by Decree-Law no. 272/2009 of 1 October.

APPLICATION

Application is submitted online via the application platform available on the institutional website and requires payment of the respective fee, determined by Maiêutica, the founding entity of the University of Maia.

NECESSARY DOCUMENTS

- ✓ Application form (on the website of the University of Maia);
- √ Passport or national identification document;
- √ Fiscal number card;
- ✓ Documentary proof of the required qualifications, as laid down in the Regulations on the International Student Statute at the University of Maia, namely:
 - Documentary proof/ves of completion of secondary education, including the grading scale used and the final grade achieved;
 - A declaration issued by the official education services in the country of origin translated into Portuguese or English, if necessary, proving that the secondary qualification held, obtained in that country, is sufficient to enter official higher education in the country for courses equivalent to the one to which the application is made, OR a certificate of equivalence to Portuguese secondary education issued by a competent national body;
 - If applicable, documentary proof of admission exams taken in the country of origin, including grades achieved (e.g. ENEM; Gaokao, Examen de Estado del Instituto Colombiano para la Evaluación de la Educación (ICFES); International Baccalaureate);
- ✓ Evidence of the knowledge of the language in which the degree programme is taught, as laid down in the Regulations on the International Student Statute of the University of Maia,
- ✓ Sworn declaration of the candidate stating that s/he is not a EU national and is not prevented from applying to UMaia under this special competition, as laid down in Decree-Law no. 36/2014 of 10 March, as amended by Decree-Law nº 62/2018 of 6 August, and in the Regulations on the International Student Statute of the University of Maia (available on UMaia's website).

PORTUGUESE LANGUAGE TEST - only for candidates from non-Portuguese-speaking countries

Courses are taught in Portuguese. Candidates from non-Portuguese speaking countries must provide evidence of their knowledge of the Portuguese language, either by providing documentary proof of the aforementioned knowledge or by sitting a language test at the University of Maia.

As laid down in the applicable legislation and regulations, candidates may be required to sit admission exams. In such cases, the exam(s) to be taken at the University of Maia depend on the course the student is applying for, as follows:

ADMISSION EXAM SYLLABUS

As per the applicable legislation and regulations, the verification of the specific academic qualification for access to the study cycle will focus on the syllabus of the admission exams of the same study cycle in the scope of the general access and entry regime, namely on the syllabus for the respective subjects for the 10th, 11th and 12th grades of Portuguese secondary education.
