- Academic staff comprises national and international renowned researchers in the field of clinical research and practice, including Prof.
 William Stiles (President of Division 29 of APA in 2013);
- It offers students the possibility of attending the course full-time (4 years) or part-time (5-6 years);
- Students can be integrated in ISMAI's Research Laboratory in Psychotherapy, integrated in the 'Centre for Psychology at University of Porto', recently classified as 'Excellent' by the Foundation for Science and Technology.
